The Ku-ring-gai Wildflower Garden is having its annual Festival of Wildflowers. Its theme is **Reconnect with Nature** and will be celebrating Biodiversity. There will be Australian native plant displays and sales, guided nature walks and experts speaking on a variety of flora and fauna topics that address biological diversity in Australia. The Festival will also feature children's activities, environmental displays, wildlife presentations and organic gardening information.

The Garden is 124 hectares of bushland with bush walking tracks, picnic areas, children's playground, bicycle track, and a wheelchair-friendly walking track.

The reason for including this event into our Sydney program is to allow members and friends to enjoy each other's company in this beautiful garden and be in touch with the spirit of Springtime. There is no structure to this gathering. You come and go whenever you like, join in whatever interests you, bring food and drinks or buy whatever is available.

The Festival is held rain or shine from 9am to 4pm. Parking is available on site or on Richmond Avenue. There is someone usually at the gates to give advice on where to park and where the Festival is located.
